
Raffle tickets are now for sale from Committee Members.

making roots


This time of year is perfect for getting out in the garden and starting to grow! Carrot (best if it still has some leaves on the carrot) Cocktail sticks, Glass of water

Method

- Fill a glass half full with water
- 2. Carefully cut the bottom off the carrot
- Stick four cocktail sticks around the top
- 4. Balance the sticks on the top of the glass, so the carrot hangs in the middle
- 5. Observe what happens over the next few days

Community Book Club


St Margaret's CE Primary School would like to invite members of the local community to participate in a book club on the following dates:




