Making roots
This time of year is perfect for getting out in the garden and starting to grow for the Flower and Veg show in August!

Materials:
Carrot (works best if it still has some leaves on the carrot)
Cocktail sticks, Glass of water

Instructions:

1. Fill a glass half full with water
2. Carefully cut the bottom off the carrot
3. Stick four cocktail sticks around the top
4. Balance the sticks on the top of the glass, so the carrot hangs in the middle
5. Observe what happens over the next few days

The carrot in the water should sprout extra white thready roots to help it soak up the water. Afterwards, you could plant your carrot in water to see if it keeps growing.
